Flu Vaccine is recommended for all persons over the age of 6 months. We have the quadrivalent vaccine which protects against 4 different flu strains. We have free flu shots for children who are uninsured or have BadgerCare or Medical Assistance and are under the age of 19 through the Vaccine for Children Program, while supplies last. Children who are covered by parent's private insurance should be immunized at their doctor's office. For adults, we can bill Medicare Part B, or your Medicare HMO if you present your card at the time of your appointment. If you do not have your card, you will have to pay at the time of service. Flu shots are \$40.00.

Things to remember when coming for your Flu Shot

- Completed Flu Consent Form
- Copy of your Insurance Card / or \$40 cash
- Wear Short Sleeves
